All Scottish Yellow Fever Vaccination Centres (YFVCs), that remained designated during 2020, are reminded that annual returns figures must be submitted each year.

Submission of the annual returns figures is a **condition of designation** and YFVCs that do not comply with this requirement **by the end of June 2021** may be suspended or de-designated.
